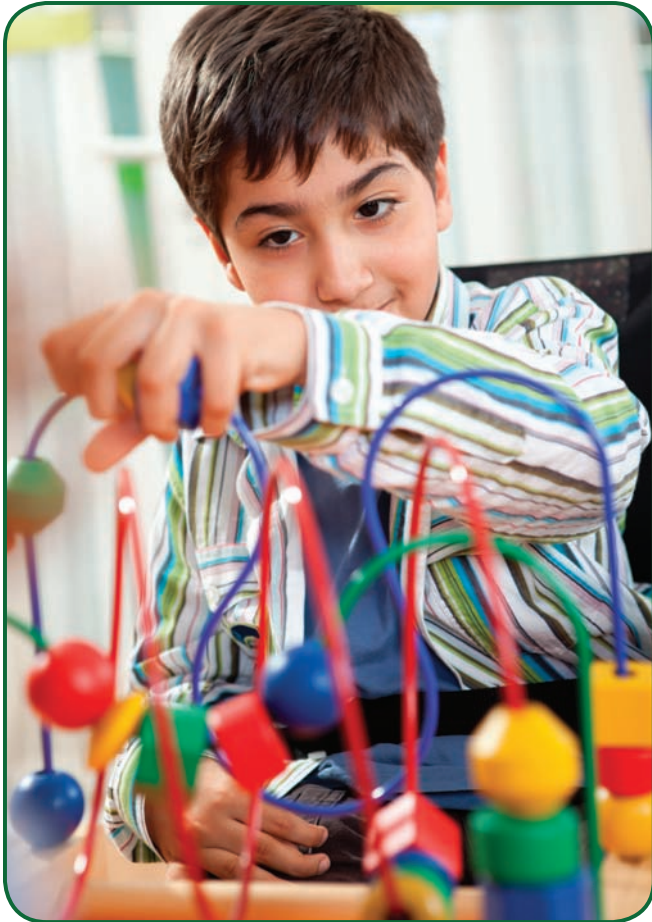

ADAPTIVE SKILL TRAINING (Service Code 605)

This systematic training program is designed to build adaptive skills and generalize mastered skills to develop greater independence in daily living activities.

Services Include:

- Communication Training
- Social/Emotional Training
- Personal Hygiene & Self-Help Skills Training
- Toilet Training
- Functional Skills Training
- Health & Safety Awareness
- Parent Training

Service For:

- **School Age** (ages 6-14)
- **Transition Age** (ages 15-17)
- **Adults** (ages 17 & up)

ENTRANCE CRITERIA:

1. A consumer, ages 6 and up, who meets the *DSM-IV-TR* (APA, 2000) criteria of or is diagnosed with developmental disorders. This does not include those who exhibit challenging behaviors such as aggression, property destruction, and/or dangerous behaviors that interfere with participation in the program.
2. A consumer demonstrating deficits in communication, functional skills, social/emotional, personal hygiene/self help, and health and safety awareness.
3. The consumer is in good health without medical issues that would preclude them from full participation in treatment.
4. A consumer who has a home environment that support the Adaptive Skills Training program.
5. Independence in basic self-care skills and is able to follow simple verbal instructions.
