SEEK's Behavior Intervention program follows the philosophy of positive programming in which we train primary caretakers/family members to reduce moderately intense challenging behaviors. The program focuses on teaching alternative behaviors as well as implementing preventative strategies. We also train the primary caretakers/family members to teach skills that are correlated

with the function of behaviors such as functional communication skills. This intervention includes functional assessment and the training of primary caretakers/family members under the guidance of our Behavior Specialists.



Behavior Assessment:

- Functional assessment of behavior excesses
- Observation in multiple environments
- Probing of alternative replacement responses
- Identifying consequent variables that maintain the behavior
- Designing positive intervention plans derived from assessment data and evidence-based methodologies

Intervention Plan:

- Occurrences of the behavior excess are reduced by manipulating the conditions that precede the challenging behavior
- Alternative or incompatible responses that replace the target behavior are identified and targeted
- Maintaining variables are identified and withheld
- Primary caretakers receive training on principles of behavior and supervision to accurately implement the behavior plan
- Alternative responses are generalized across settings and people, and maintained over time
- Ongoing data analysis to review the efficacy of intervention plans and to make informed clinical decisions
